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## **Teen Age Menstrual Problems Genital Tuberculosis a Strong Possibility**

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This is a study of adolescent menstrual problems in 2 years period at Cama and Albless Hospital. The various causative factors of diagnostic pitfalls are discussed and importance of early diagnosis and treatment emphasized. Genital tuberculosis was found to be cause number 1 in this socioeconomic class.

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## **Unusual Presentations of Tuberculosis in Children**

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Tuberculosis is a common disease in our country affecting people of all age groups and different organ systems. We present two unusual cases of tuberculosis abdomen- a) loculated ascites in the lesser sac, b) plastic type of tuberculous abdomen with caseating nodes presenting as intestinal obstruction in a 9 month old child. The aim of presenting this case is to make one aware of this condition since it is normally not considered in the differential diagnosis of obstruction at this age.

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## **Tuberculous Stricture of Pelvi-Ureteric Junction in Solitary Kidney**

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Occurrence of tuberculous stricture at pelvi-ureteric junction (PUJ) in a solitary kidney with acute renal failure is described here. Patient had associated pulmonary tuberculosis with effusion. The case was successfully managed by Foley-Y plasty (stented) and postoperative Antikoch's therapy consisted of rifampicin/isoniazid/pyrazinamide and ethambutol.

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
